



## Lake Wallenpaupack Watershed Management District Watershed Improvement Cost-Share Program

The LWWMD is currently accepting applications for watershed improvement projects within the Lake Wallenpaupack Watershed. Residential, commercial, and community properties are eligible. Grants will be made available for a 50% match of eligible project costs up to a maximum of \$10,000. (For example-If your project costs \$20,000 the LWWMD will provide up to a \$10,000 match.) Priority will be given to projects that reduce or eliminate the flow of pollutants into Lake Wallenpaupack, and those that provide greater than 50% landowner match.
